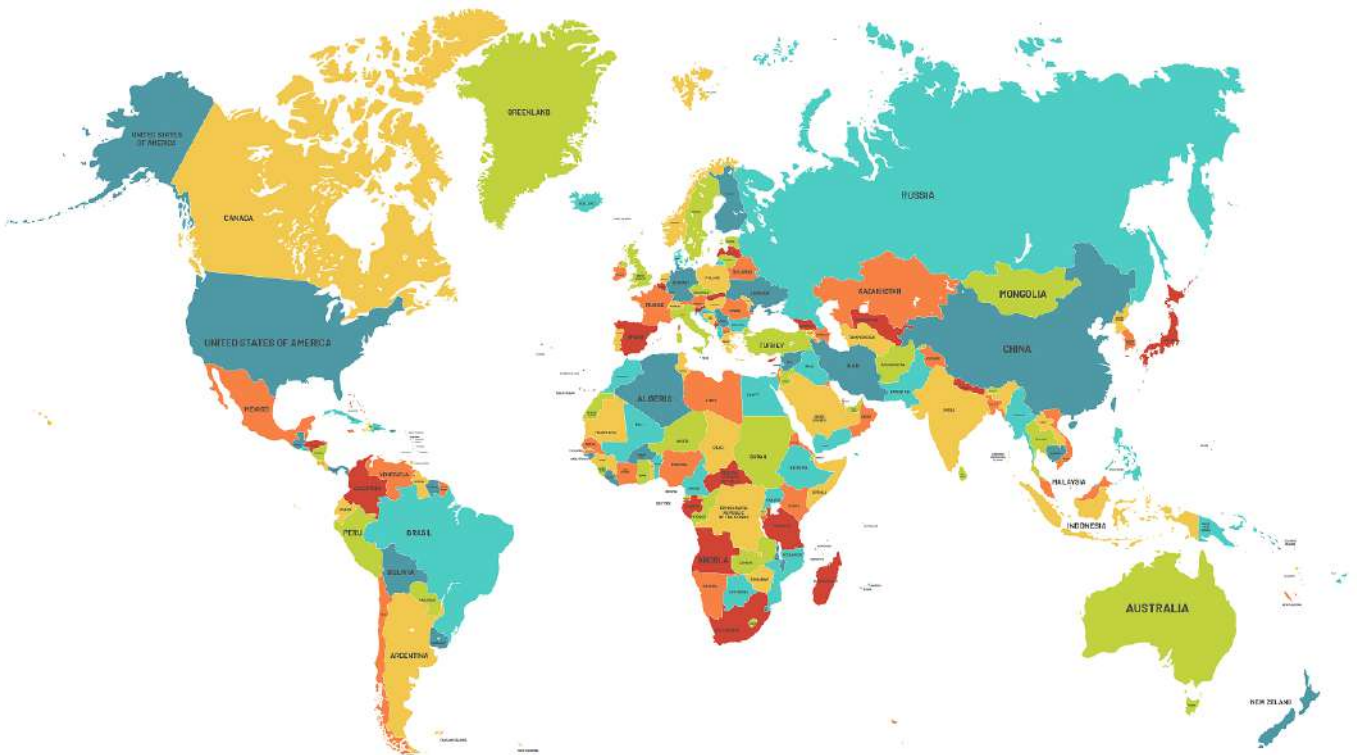

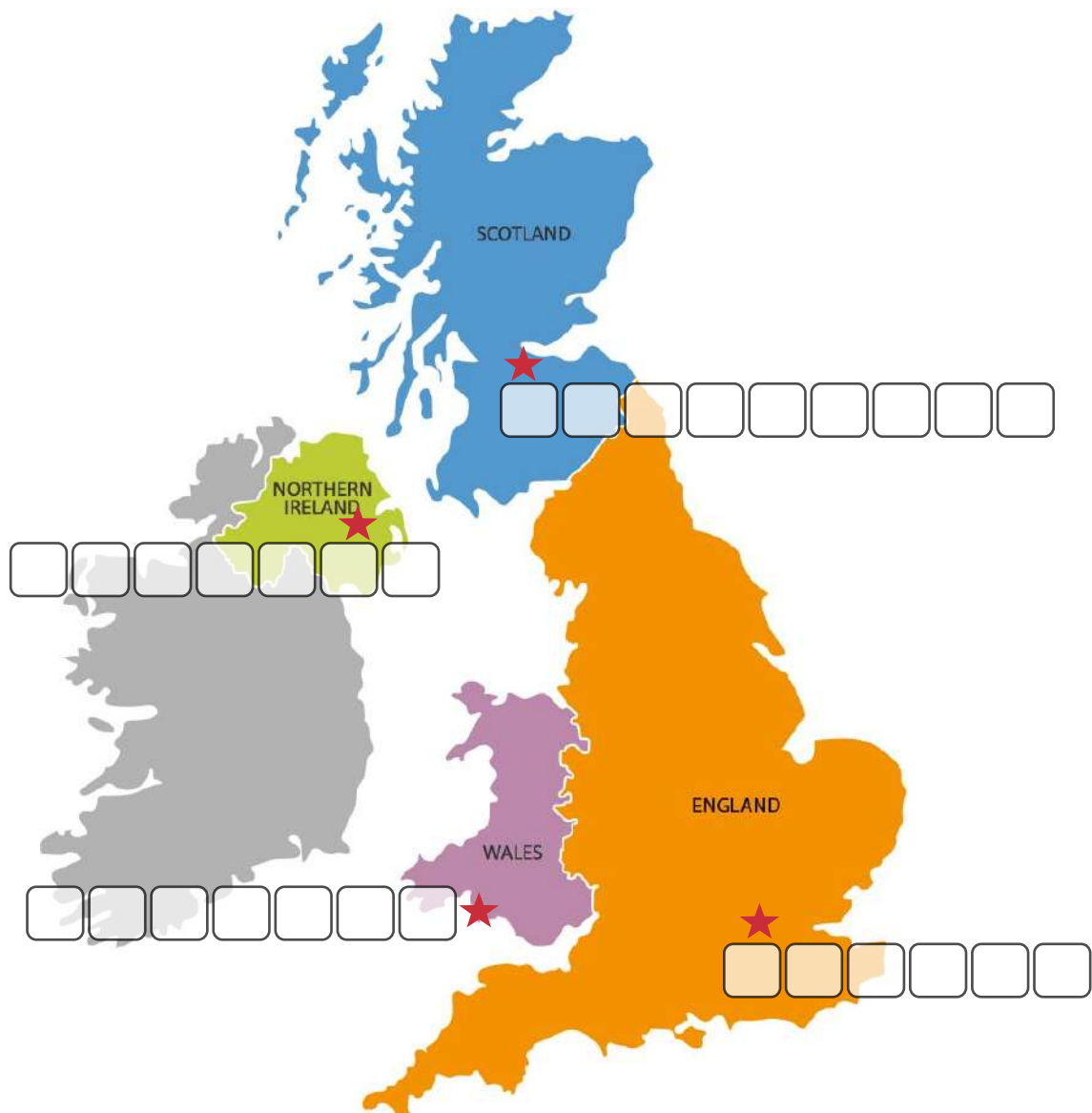

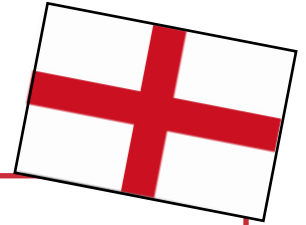

The people from USA are very good at making movies and sending rockets out in space.

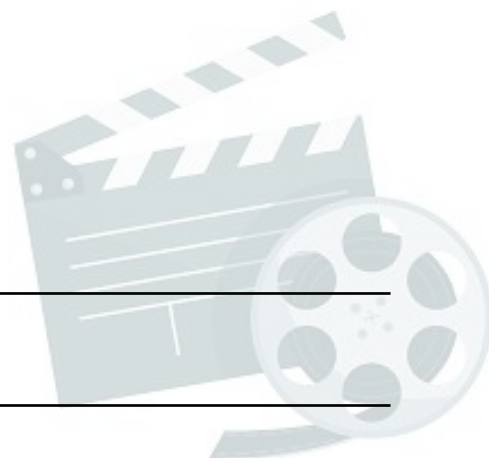

Mia is 10 years old and lives in New York.

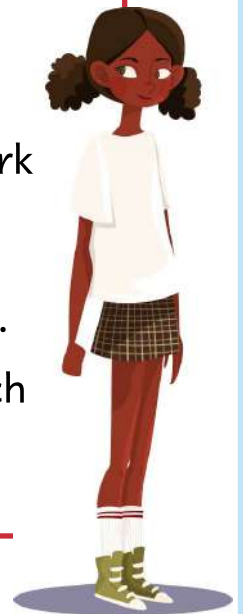

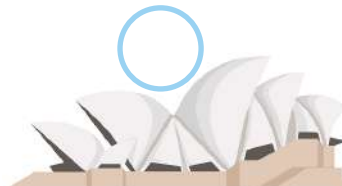
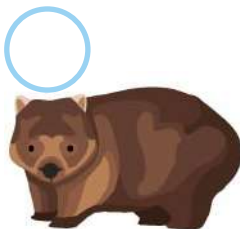
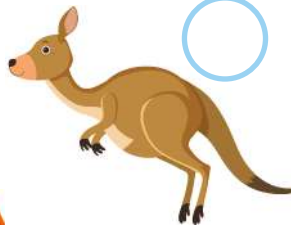
In the year 1788 England started to use Australia as a prison. They sailed people that broke the law across the sea to Australia, where they could start a new life.

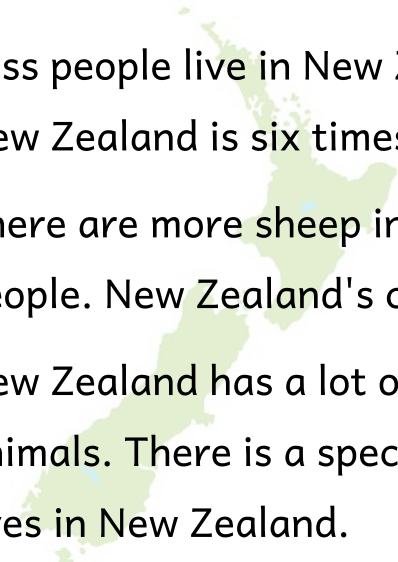
New Zealand

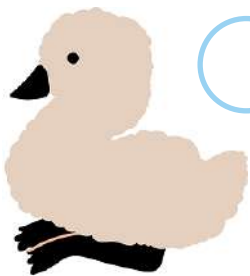
Denmark is a very flat country and Danes like to ride their bikes.

Danes are very good at playing handball and wins a lot of medals. Danish children also love to play handball and other sports.

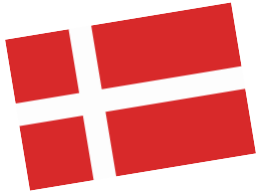
Danes like to eat a special bred that's called rye bread. Rye bread is mostly made of kernels and seeds.

The Danish capital is Copenhagen. In Copenhagen the famous little mermaid sits on a rock.

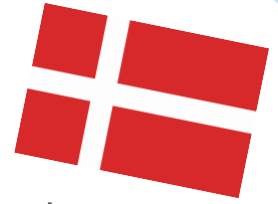
