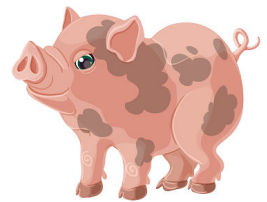

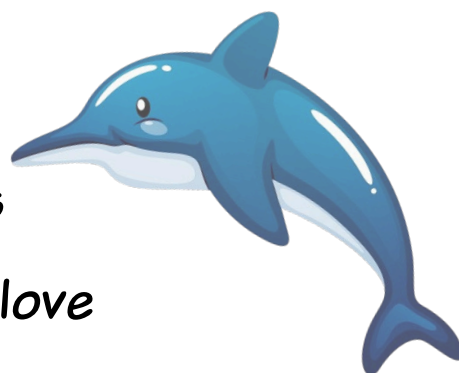

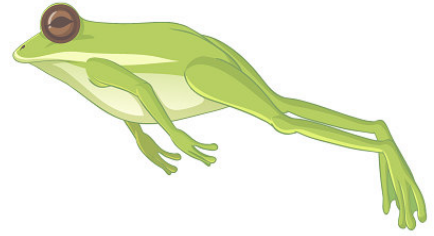

# Frog

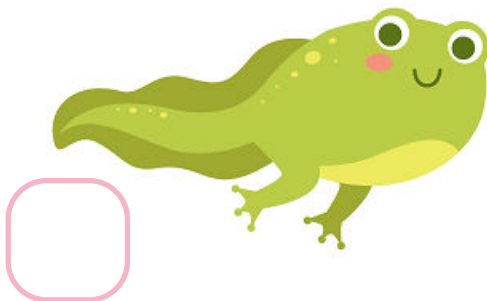
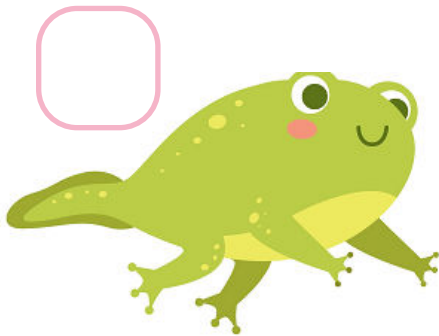


Frogs live both in water and on land. They eat insects and are known for their croaking sounds.

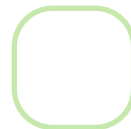
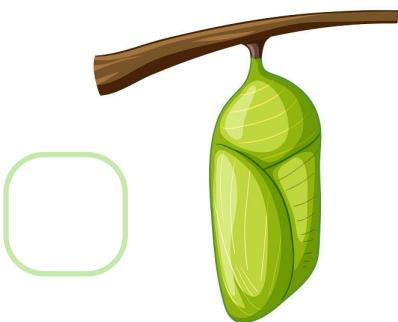
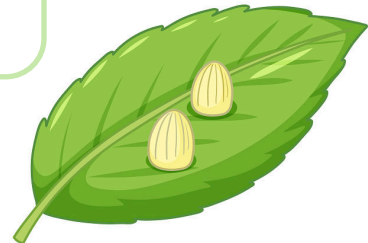
# Butterfly

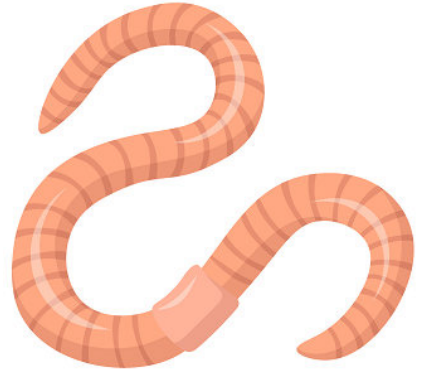
