What is Thanksgiving?

Thanksgiving is a special holiday. It is mostly celebrated in the United States and Canada.

A national holiday



From harvest festival to national holiday

In 1863, President Abraham Lincoln made it a national holiday. He did this to help bring people together, because at that time there was a war in the United States.

A woman named Sarah Hale sent many letters to the president, asking him to make Thanksgiving a national holiday so that everyone could celebrate together.
